



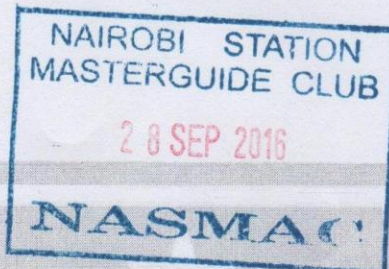

It is our sincere hope that you are doing fine in the Lord's vineyard. We trust you are moving on under the Lord's banner making disciples for Him.



Registration fee is KES. 700, payable by October 9, 2016. Registration includes KES. 350 Park Entry Fee and a much subsidised transport cost of KES. 350 to and from Nairobi town. We have organized buses to ferry us from town and back at the subsidized rate of KES. 350. Kindly remit your registration of KES. 700 by October 9, 2016 to help us in planning. Carry packed lunch and enough drinking water. Meeting time in town is 7.30a.m. at a site to be announced soon.

Other events this year are as follows:

- a. Universities & Colleges Senior Youth Test to be held on October 9, 2016 at University of Nairobi; Chiromo Campus. Registration is KES. 300, payable by October 3, 2016.
